## **GUIDED WALKING TRAIL**

## around BAMPTON

Bampton in Devon is a beautiful and fascinating small town with a long, and chequered history from the ancient Britons to modern times. The trail is led by volunteers who will walk you through the town highlighting the social, cultural, industrial and religious changes it has seen. These are reflected in the history of the buildings you will see around you.

The trail begins and ends at the Heritage and Visitor Centre which is located in St. Michael and All Angels Parish Church and takes between one and one and a half hours. It is on mostly level ground and is quite suitable for wheelchairs and mobility aids.

If time allows you could combine a trail with a visit to the Heritage Centre where displays include local history boards, display cases of artefacts, photographs, videos, and a model of Bampton when it was a railway town.

The Church itself is a grade one listed building.

TOWN TRAILS occur once a month and are advertised locally. They can also be arranged on request for groups of four or more. The cost is £2-50 per person with all the money going to the upkeep of the Heritage Centre.
