 - iii. Fair website to be updated by June 2024. Cllr. L. Bull noted that Humphrey Berridge has done an exceptional job on behalf of the Fair and out of season will be a good time to update and modernise the Fair website.
 - iv. Mummers play, timings to be agreed. Need to check on the timings of Titan in order to avoid a clash with the Mummers.
 - v. Check is there to be a busking piano and/or a climbing wall (Scouts). No busking piano. There is to be a climbing wall Clerk to action with Adam Padget
 - vi. Exmoor pony same place as previous two years; to be checked. Yes and in the same place.
- vii. Chicken auction; likely to go ahead? If so where? This could go ahead but bird flu is on the increase. Council decided not to go ahead this year. Proposed Cllr. White; all agreed.
- viii. Signage in particular the ones that are sited on the roads advising of the forthcoming road closures. Still under discussion as a Chapter 8 trained person is required to work on the roads. October agenda.
- ix. Music to discuss. Cllr. Grabke reported on behalf of Ed Tanner spoken to some local music acts; there will be a small marquee outside the Laundry Room for the musicians. Cllr. White proposed a budget of £600 for musical acts to play during the day.
