



Guided Town Trail

The Bampton Heritage & Visitor Centre offers Guided Town Trails for small groups by arrangement.

Bampton has a long history, from ancient Britons, Romans, Anglo-Saxons and Normans, through to modern times, and evidence of all these ages can be seen around the town. Lasting approximately one and a half hours and mostly on level ground, a Guided Town Trail will walk you through many features which a casual visitor might miss, highlighting the social, cultural, industrial and religious development of the town. The Trail begins and ends at the Heritage & Visitor Centre, located in St Michael and All Angels Church, where displays include local history boards, artefacts, photographs and a model of Bampton's railway station. Why not combine your Trail with a visit to the Heritage Centre and to one of the excellent restaurants, pubs and cafes in Bampton?
