There has been a long standing need for a new hall in Bampton.

Bampton Town Council has identified two options for creating one new hall to replace the existing halls.

OPTION ONE

The land behind the Community Hall is for sale by the Exeter Diocese. This land and the hall have been offered to the Council at a surveyed cost of £215,000. If purchased, the hall could be developed and extended, probably remaining single storey.

OPTION TWO

The land at the end of the car park, currently occupied by the junior play area, is already owned by the Council and could be used to build a new hall, possibly two storey and incorporating a newly equipped junior playground.

Both options would involve financing through fund raising, finding grants and possibly a loan, which would be repaid over a number of years.
